Sgt Joseph D. Sigler

Sergeant Joseph D Sigler was born in Santa Ana, California on 16 January 1998. He attended recruit training from July 5th, 2016 – September 30th, 2016, aboard MCRD Parris Island graduating as a Private First Class. Following recruit training, PFC Sigler attended Marine Combat Training at Camp Geiger, NC and Ammunition School in Fort Lee, VA.

On January 23rd, 2017, PFC Sigler reported to Detachment 1, Supply Company, Combat Logistics Battalion 451, Combat Logistics Regiment 45. On April 1st, 2017, PFC Sigler was promoted to Lance Corporal.

In June 2018, LCpl Sigler completed his annual training at MCAGCC Twentynine Palms, CA assigned to both the Storage and Issues sections for Reserve ITX-2018. In August 2018, LCpl Sigler was assigned to 4th Squad, 1st Platoon, Det 1 Sup Co as a Fire Team Leader.

In June 2019, LCpl Sigler completed annual training with a small group of 4 Marines at Camp Lejeune, NC to work in the Records Section and learn the Ordnance Information System (OIS).
